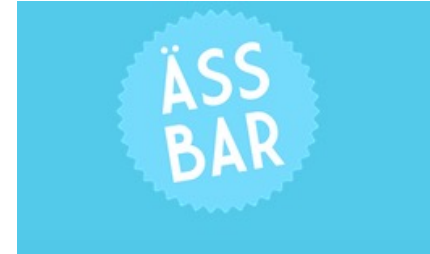
Sustainability and cooperation

Decroissance Basel



Project “Trinational cooperation platform for sustainability initiatives, social work institutions and sustainability-oriented companies”

Aims at illuminating **sustainability-relevant potentials** through (**digital**) **cooperation** between sustainability initiatives, social work institutions and sustainability-oriented companies in the Upper-Rhine Area.

Overall RQ is: **What are interlinkages between social, environmental and economic sustainability that can be used by initiatives, institutions or companies/start-ups for cooperation?**

In cooperation with EH Freiburg, Germany:

Social work students work on related RQ, exchange with them and eventually representatives from sustainability initiatives, social work institutions and sustainability-oriented companies is planned.

Group work of MSD students – framework, desktop research and first cooperation ideas

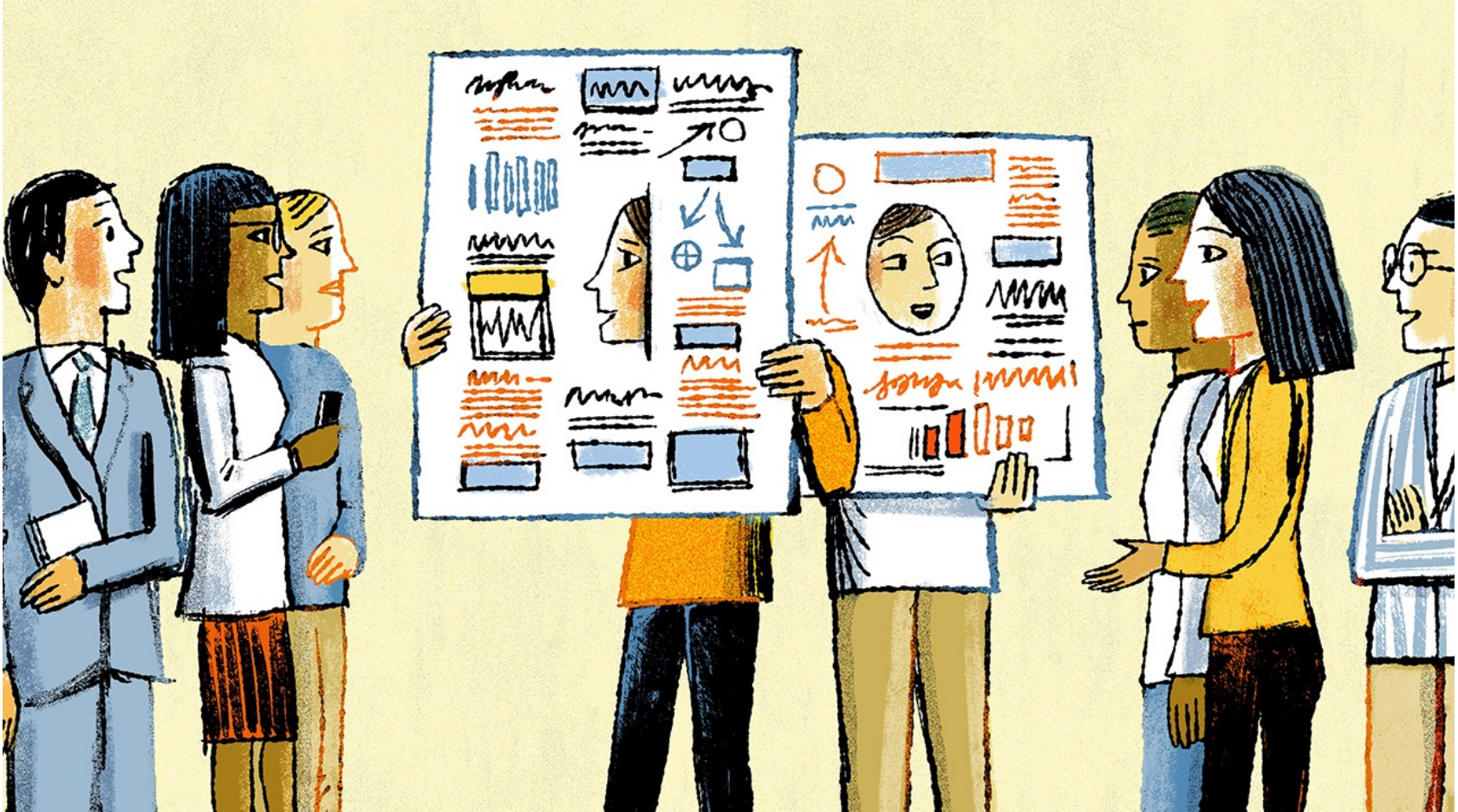
